The Summer 2019 Drivers Education Program will run from Monday, July 1st through Thursday, August 29th, 2019 at Longwood High School. While incoming Seniors have preference, the program will be available to Juniors as well, but limited to 48 students who must be at least sixteen (16) years of age on or before registration. Those attending Summer School are not eligible to apply for the Summer Driver Education program.

Transportation to and from the high school must be provided by parent or guardian.

The Summer Driver Education Program consists of two lecture classes and two driving classes per week. A marble notebook is required for all lecture classes. **Absolutely NO absences are acceptable** during the summer session due to condensed classes and required hours.

Registration will take place on June 3th & 4th for incoming Seniors and June 5th & 6th for incoming Juniors. The course is \$420, and you can register on www.MySchoolBucks.com. You must choose your lecture and driving session and add them to your cart at the same time when registering. Failure to do so may result in a declined order.

Classes are held as follows:

Lecture meets in room 1111 on Mondays and Wednesdays 8:30 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.

Or

Lecture meets in room 1111 on Tuesdays and Thursdays 8:30 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.

Driving meets at the field house on Mondays and Wednesdays 8:30, 10:00 or 11:30a.m.

Or

Driving meets at the field house on Tuesday and Thursday 8:30, 10:00 or 11:30 a.m.

Your choices are not guaranteed as classes are very limited

There will be no make-up classes for the Summer Session.
